

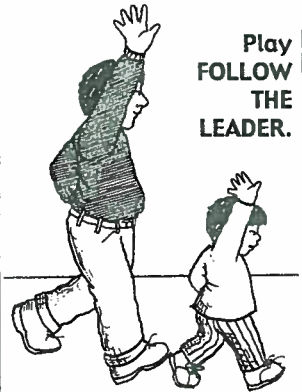

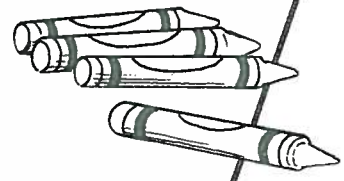
Learn and recite 5 LITTLE PUMPKINS SITTING ON A GATE.
