READING TIPS

Become a Label Maker—Your Preschooler knows what a door is. She knows bed, table and chair. Take her comprehension one step further by labeling all of these commonly used items so she learns to recognize what the word looks like. Use name tags "bed", "table", "chair"... on index cards and tape or place them on everything in the house that your Preschooler encounters on a regular basis. Talk to her about them. Ask her what the object in question is and then point to the word.

After a week or so try removing the cards and make a list with your Preschooler. See which ones she remembers. Then, compare the list to the cards and ask her to match the cards with the words on her list.

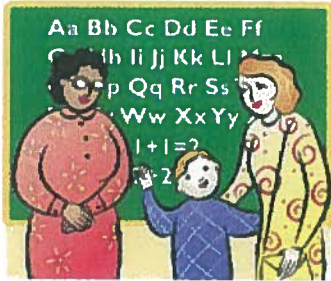

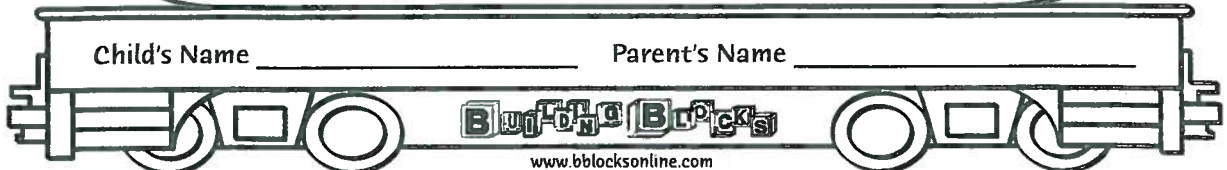
