## Mrs. Schultze's Corner

The preschool years are perhaps one of the most creative periods of development. Creative thinking will be critical when our preschoolers grow-up since many of the jobs of the future are not yet created. Creativity can be defined as identifying problems and finding solutions. We can encourage creativity through play and what we call "loose parts." You can encourage creativity in many ways. You can collect natural treasures such as rocks, flowers, snow or ice, leaves, or things around the house such as cotton balls, clothes pins, and recycled materials. Use these random items in imaginative play or to create art work. Compare how they look or sound as they fall. You can use scraps of wood or cardboard as building blocks. Challenge your child to explore and create each day! You can find great ideas in the book Loose Parts. Inspiring Play in Children by Lisa Daly.

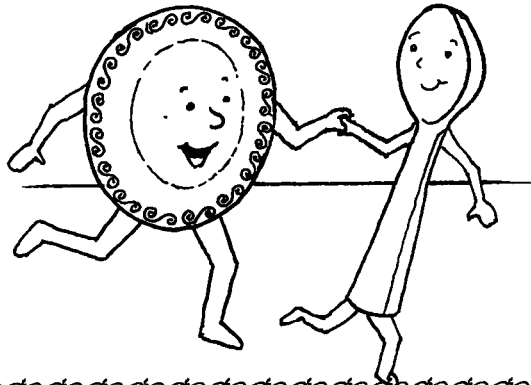

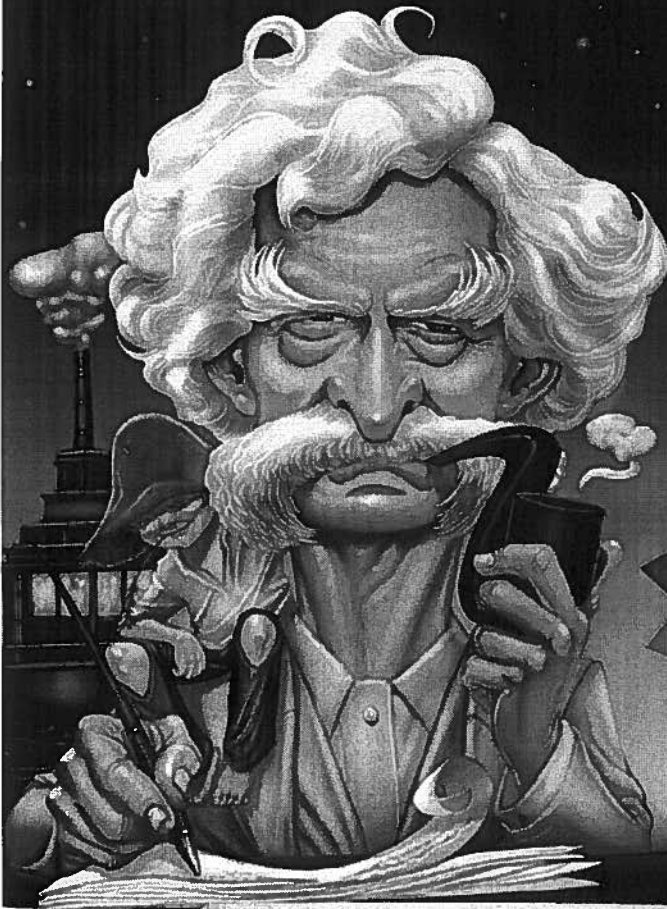
