Mrs. Schultze's Corner

Repetition is a child's friend. Did you ever wonder why your child wants you to read the same book over and over again? Children love to hear the same story for many reasons. They are nurtured by your touch and being in your lap as you read. They feel safe with an activity that gives their brain structure with a familiar routine. A child's brain is ready to learn when he or she feels safe and loved. As we learn new things, we need to hear them more than once for our brains to put them in long term memory. "Rehearsal" is the processing of information that allows us to hold information in our working memory to insure transfer to long term memory. Did you know that you must practice a skill 24 times for 80% retention? The more we practice something the more it becomes part of our long term memory. Learning rhymes and songs and reading books provides the repetition needed for children to learn new skills. Reading, singing, and talking as you play together, all build the skills needed to be successful in school. We wish you a safe and relaxing spring break. We will see you in April!
