PRESCHOOL SUPPLY LIST



**Backpack** – This is our line of communication. Your child needs a backpack with a zipper (items don't fall out of bags with a zipper); large enough for projects and supplies. Help your child learn responsibility by modeling it. Please check the backpack daily for projects, important notes, etc. **SOME PAPERS NEED TO BE RETURNED ON SPECIFIED DATES.** We will also check your child's backpack when he/she arrives at school for communications from home.

**Clothing** – *Be sure your child wears clothing that allows him/her the freedom to explore activities with no fear of ruining clothing or upsetting parents.* Each child needs a set of warm and cool weather clothing (short/long sleeve shirt, shorts/long pants, underclothing, and socks) at school for accidents. There are many kinds of accidents: bathroom, spills at meals/projects, etc. **MARK JACKETS & BACKPACKS WITH THE CHILD'S NAME.** Most preschoolers can't claim belongings when misplaced.

**Diaper Supplies** - Those students who are not toilet trained must provide diapers/Velcro pull-ups.

**Wipes** – one container per semester

**Folder** – two plastic, folders with pockets; one green & one orange

**Glue Sticks** – four per semester

**Tissues** – one large box each semester for runny noses, tears, etc

**Zipper Storage Bags** - one box of 2 or 2 ½ gallon sizes, one box of quart, one box of snack

**5 oz cups** – one box/package per semester

**Napkins** – one package **AFTERNOON class only**

**Disinfectant Wipes** – one container per semester

**Pip Squeak markers** – one package **MORNING class only**

**White gift bag** – non-glossy for Valentine's Day

**Photo Album** – 4 x 6 plastic (special project)

**Brown Paper Bag** – two large

**Cooking Supplies** – donations will be requested as needed

**Other items** – as supplies dwindle throughout the year you may be asked to send more; other items may be requested throughout the year for special projects.
